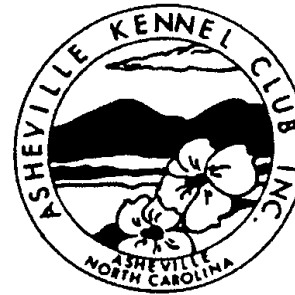

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

FROM SOUTH (from Greenville) and West (from Knoxville): Travel East on I-26 or I-40. Merge onto I-240 towards Asheville. Take Exit 3A (left Lane) onto Rte. 19/23 South/Patton Avenue. Travel three lights to Louisiana Avenue (Kentucky Fried Chicken is on the left corner). Turn LEFT onto Louisiana Ave then right into the U.S. Army Reserve Center. Parking and entrance is behind the building

FROM East on I-40 (from Raleigh): Travel West on I-40. Merge onto I-240 going through Asheville. When crossing the Smoky Park Bridge, continue straight onto Rte. 19/23 South/Patton Avenue. Travel three lights to Louisiana Avenue (Kentucky Fried Chicken is on the left corner). Turn LEFT onto Louisiana Ave then right into the U.S. Army Reserve Center. Parking and entrance is behind the building

From the North (from Johnson City): Travel on I-26 East / Rte 19/23 South. Merge onto I-240 West and cross the bridge. Continue straight onto Rte. 19/23 South/Patton Avenue. Travel three lights to Louisiana Avenue (Kentucky Fried Chicken is on the left corner). Turn LEFT onto Louisiana Ave then right into the U.S. Army Reserve Center. SHOW REGULATIONS

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES: 9:00 pm, Wednesday, September 21, 2011 at the Trial Secretaries office, 21 Bartlett Road, Weaverville, NC 28787

ENTRY FEE: \$24.00 for the first entry of each dog in obedience and \$20.00 for each additional entry of the same dog (including fee(s) A \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee and a recording fee of \$.50 will be required for each dog entered at a Licensed Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, Rally Trial or Tracking Test. These Event and Recording fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only (American Kennel Club Rules, Chapter 11, Section 2).

ALL ENTRIES ARE TO BE MAILED WITH FEES TO: Susan M Young, Trial Secretary, 21 Bartlett Road, Weaverville, NC 28787 CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS should be made payable to the ASHEVILLE KENNEL CLUB, payable in U.S. funds. Post dated and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The club will add a collection fee to the amount of the returned check. TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES CAN NOT BE ACCEPTED.

ENTRIES NOT ON AN OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM and photocopies of entry forms WITHOUT THE AGREEMENT/RULES on the reverse of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT FEES. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practicable with confirmation letters. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Trial Secretary. NO ENTRY shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

ERROR ON ENTRY BLANKS: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

ENTRY FEE shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by the action of a Trial Committee. If, because of rots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fee will be made. ENTRY FEE will be refunded for bitches who come in season after the closing date of the Trial with a written statement from a Veterinarian.

OBEDIENCE TRIAL HOURS are from 7:30 am to 6:00 pm

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR THE TIME OF JUDGING. DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. DOGS NOT REQUIRED for further judging will be excused. **JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS.** The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it's class is to be judged. SPACE FOR UNENTERED DOGS WILL NOT BE PROVIDED at this trial. **ALL DOGS PRESENT must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged** CRATING SPACE WILL BE PROVIDED RINGSIDE BUT SPACE IS LIMITED. **ALL EXHIBITORS MUST CLEAN UP AFTER THEIR DOGS.** DOGS MAY ONLY BE EXERCISED IN DESIGNATED AREAS.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
